Free School Meal Vouchers:

The Free School Meal vouchers for the December holidays will be getting issued next week. We will send a Parent App out when these are ready to collect from the School office.

School has recently purchased software allowing us to apply on your behalf to the City Council to check if your are eligible for Free School Meals. All children in Reception to Year 2 receive Universal Free School Meals and do not pay for school lunches. Once your child is in Year 3 or above there is a charge for these. If you are eligible for Free School Meals you would not need to pay for lunches and you will also be eligible for the Holiday Food Vouchers which the City Council currently issues during school holidays.

Winter HAF (Holiday Activity an Food) Programme:

There are a number of HAF Programmes taking place over the Christmas Holidays which children can attend (this is FREE for all children eligible for benefit related free school meals). This includes breakfasts, lunches and snacks each day children attend as well as sports and other activities.
