In school, children completed activities throughout the day to raise awareness about Safer Internet Day, including BBC live lessons about AI and taking part in our Cyber Superhero design competition.





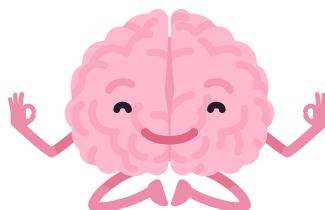
Children's Mental Health Week:
