HOW TO ENTER...

2. Remember to make it bold and colourful. It can be anything you like, patterns, animals, nature, music - what would you like to see on them when you walk down Smithdown Road?
3. Smithdown in Bloom's artist Sarah will be judging the final entries at the event at Greenbank School on Saturday 20th April. There will be a winner from each of the 3 year age groups (EYFS / KS1 / KS2), with the winner from each group having their design on one side of one planter.

1. If your artwork is chosen it will be replicated by the Smithdown in Bloom artist in real scale on a physical planter on Smithdown Road for everyone to see.
2. You will get a certificate to show for your wonderful work.
